COUNCIL MEETING
August 12, 2019

The Town Council of Bogue met Monday, August 12, 2019 at the Bogue Town Hall, 121 Chimney Branch Road. Mayor Richard Taylor called the meeting to order at 6:02pm.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, Councilman David Padgett led a prayer.

Department Reports

Financial - Mayor Taylor- General Fund checking \$421,118; Petty Cash \$67; Powell Bill \$44,778; total \$465,963.

Budget Report – Clerk Sweeney – All real property and motor vehicle property tax collection for the last fiscal year presented. Budget report with preliminary final amounts presented for FY18-19.

Planner Report – Clerk Sweeney - Permits issued: no new permits since last meeting.

A second revision of fire safety inspection procedure sent to WCFD chief and clerk.

Planning board signed approval of a family subdivision for Albert Taylor on West Hilltop Drive. The purpose of the subdivision is to divide out 2.0 acres for Mr. Taylor's daughter. The second parcel, 1.38 acres, will remain Albert Taylor's. The map was reviewed by the Council. The address change of the two new parcels was discussed. It has changed to 151 and 165 West Hilltop Drive. The private street [West Hilltop Drive] is now paved to just past 151 West Hilltop Dr. The home there was destroyed in Hurricane Florence and will be replaced.

The planning board continues to review the Code of Ordinance and has completed through Title VII. Clerk is meeting with ECC tomorrow to review the zoning chapter.

Street Report - Councilmen O'Chat – All the paving/resurfacing scheduled is completed.

Town Hall Report – Councilman Wilton – no report
