COUNCIL MEETING
July 15, 2019

The Town Council of Bogue met Monday, July 15, 2019 at the Bogue Town Hall, 121 Chimney Branch Road. Mayor Richard Taylor called the meeting to order at 6:01pm.

Agenda

New Business – Discussion on the fire safety inspection procedure. A few items need clarification from WCFD. Discussion started on the changes to fire safety inspection ordinance. Councilman Page made a **Motion** to approve the Revised Fire Safety Inspection Ordinance, second by Councilman Wilton, passed unanimously. The procedure will be discussed at the August meeting.

Budget Report – Clerk Sweeney – Real property and motor vehicle property tax collection for the last fiscal year presented. Budget report with preliminary final amounts presented for FY18-19. McGladrey will pick up files on Thursday to prepare financial statement for audit.

Planner Report – Clerk Sweeney Permits issued: none. Planning board did not meet in July, will meet August 1.

ILA – Councilman Padgett– At the meeting last week the budget was amended for new A/C for entire building.

Street Report - Councilmen O'Chat – The paving/resurfacing will be completed at the end of July.

Town Hall Report – Councilman Wilton – no report

Miscellaneous Reports/Announcements – Eastern Carolina Council requested a yearly municipal appointment. Councilman O’Chat made a Motion to reappoint Clerk Sweeney, second by Councilman Padgett, passed unanimously.
