COUNCIL MEETING
September 16, 2019

The Town Council of Bogue met Monday, September 16, 2019 at the Bogue Town Hall, 121 Chimney Branch Road. Mayor Richard Taylor called the meeting to order at 5:58pm.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, Councilman Eddie Morton led a prayer.

Council members present: Mayor Taylor, Herbert Page, Bobby O'Chat, David Padgett, Eddie Morton, and Charlie Wilton. Also present was Town Clerk Elizabeth Sweeney.

Agenda

Councilman Page made a **Motion** to accept the agenda. Motion was seconded by Councilman Morton. Motion was approved unanimously.

New Business – Update on Hurricane Dorian: No damages reported, clerk worked 11 hours from home on storm related web meetings. No debris collection scheduled. A tree down on Chimney Branch Rd was cut up by fire department and will be removed by town. It was noted several debris piles in Lake Arthur area have been put out. There will be no collection of debris; residents are responsible for their own vegetation debris.

Department Reports

Financial - Mayor Taylor- General Fund checking \$430,596; Petty Cash \$100; Powell Bill \$44,780; total \$475,476.

Budget Report – Clerk Sweeney – All accounts are normal for this month. To date 10.3% of budget income received, 16% of budget expense paid. Most income is added in January and February.

Planner Report – Clerk Sweeney –

Population estimate change. From 2010 to 2017 a 6.3% increase.

Street Report - Councilmen O'Chat – Brush will be cut back in areas that need it.

Town Hall Report – Councilman Wilton – the generator was checked and filled with fresh fuel before Hurricane Dorian. It was not used.
